

Aim

Why do we have an E-Safety policy?

The internet is a fantastic educational tool and can be great fun when sharing the right information with others but it does have its dangers and we want you to be safe on-line.

What does on-line bullying mean?

On-bullying means using computers, mobile phones, or other technology to hurt, scare, or embarrass other people.

DO

Ask permission from a member of Staff before accessing the internet

Use only **your** login and password which you should not share

Use our computers for school and home learning only

Remember to log out when you have finished a session

Always send polite and sensible messages to people

TELL SOMEONE if you see anything you are unhappy with.

DON'T

Access other children's files

Bring in your own memory stick into school

Ever send your picture or any personal information to others unless your Parent/Carer or member of Staff has given you permission

Ever arrange to meet anyone over the internet

Reply to any contact that upsets you
