Year 1	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Practise their phonics at home each day. Handwriting practise. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. See additional sheets with ideas and games to play.</p>
Year 2	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Practise their phonics at home each day. Handwriting practise. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. Practise each of the 4 calculations with your child: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Look at problem solving type questions. Children can complete activities about telling the time, 2d and 3d shapes and fractions. Year 3	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Handwriting practise. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. Practise each of the 4 calculations with your child: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Look at problem solving type questions. Practise their time stables. Look at telling the time. Research the Romans.</p>
Year 4	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Handwriting practise. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. Practise each of the 4 calculations with your child: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Look at problem solving type questions. Practise their times tables. Look at telling the time. Research and compare Spain and UK</p>
Year 5	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Handwriting practise. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. Practise each of the 4 calculations with your child: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Look at problem solving type questions. Practise their times tables.</p>
Year 6	<p>Please read with your child daily and use the bookmarks for comprehension questions. Practise their spellings from their wordlist. Practise each of the 4 calculations with your child: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Look at problem solving type questions. Practise their times tables. Encourage your child to complete the CGP/10 in 10 SATs revision papers.</p>
